Service, Safety and Recreation Committee Minutes
April 1, 2019

The Service, Safety and Recreation Committee met in the Lower Level Conference Room, located at 105 N. Main Street, on Monday, April 1, 2019 at 4:00 PM. 1. Mr. Hunter addressed the Committee and inquired if the Committee had any suggestions regarding improving the attendance and awareness for Relay for Life. The Committee noted several avenues of advertising and awareness options for Mr. Hunters benefit.
2. The Committee benefited from a general report of the Washington Police Department and Washington Fire Department.
3. The Administration advised the Committee of a desire to place a mirror in the alley behind Municipal Court. The Committee recommended proceeding with the request.
4. The Administration advised the Committee of Patrolman Derek Pfeifer's promotion to Sergeant and Sergeant Jeff Funari's promotion to Lieutenant.
5. The Committee benefited from a review of Service Department projects.
6. The Committee noted the employment of Mr. Kevin Roberts and Mr. Thomas Reeves to the Street Department and Mr. Kyle Garret to the Water Plant.
7. The Committee benefited from a review of the NPDES MS4 storm water report.
8. The Committee recommended that the Administration be granted permission to enter into contract with ODOT for the purchase of salt for the 2019/2020 year and that legislation be brought to Council.
9. The Committee recommended that legislation be brought to Council recommending the bid of Cox Paving for the 2019 Street and Alley Resurfacing Program.
10. The Committee recommended that the Administration be granted permission to bid a splash pad for Eyman Park.
