

**CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE**  
**Service, Safety and Recreation Committee Minutes**  
**May 12, 2021**

The Service, Safety and Recreation Committee met in the Council Chambers, located at 105 N. Main Street, on Monday, May 12, 2021 at 6:00 pm. Mr. Ted Hawk presided and those in attendance were; Mr. Dale Lynch, Council Member, Ms. Kendra Hernandez, Council Member, Mr. Jim Blair, Council Member, Mr. Steve Shiltz, Council Member, Mr. Jim Chrisman, Council Chairperson, Mr. Ron Sockman, Service Director, Mr. Jeff Funari, Police Chief, Mr. Tim Downing, Fire Chief, Mr. Joe Denen, City Manager, and Mr. Mark Pitstick, City Attorney.

1. The Committee benefited from a general report of the Washington Police Department and Washington Fire Department. Chief Downing noted that maintenance continued on the fire hydrants.
2. Chief Funari noted that two candidates had been hired for the Police Patrol position. Chief Funari continued and noted that one would begin in May and the other would be hired in July.
3. The Committee benefited from a review of Service Department projects. The Committee noted that paving would begin June 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. The Administration advised the Committee that speed signs will be placed on Elm Street by Washington High/Middle School.
5. The Committee recommended that legislation be brought to Council to enter into an agreement with Coughlin Ford for the purchase of 2021 Cemetery dump truck not to exceed \$41,627.00.
6. The Committee recommended that legislation be brought to Council to enter into an agreement with Beford Ford for the purchase of two 2021 pickup trucks for the Street Department not to exceed \$63,080.52.
7. The Committee noted the interest in community a disc golf course for the community. The Committee recommended discussions continue with all parties regarding construction of the course.
